YOU MUST SEE THE VISION BEFORE YOU CAN ACHIEVE IT

Main Texts: Habakkuk 2:2-3;
Genesis 13:14-17; Proverbs 29:18

A God-given vision is more than a personal ambition; it is a spiritual picture of the future God desires for us. God often allows us to see by faith what He intends to accomplish before it becomes a visible reality.

The Lord told Abraham to lift his eyes and look at the land He would give him (Genesis 13:14-15). Likewise, we must look beyond our present limitations and trust God's promises, for "we walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Corinthians 5:7). A vision must

be made clear. God told Habakkuk,



"Write the vision, and make it plain" (Habakkuk 2:2). Writing the vision gives us direction and helps us develop a practical plan.

We should prayerfully identify the steps, resources, training, and relationships needed to fulfill the assignment. Vision requires both faith and careful planning. Vision also requires preparation and action. Noah did not merely hear God's warning; he obeyed and built the ark according to God's instructions (Genesis 6:14, 22). James 2:17

reminds us that faith without works is dead.

Therefore, we must take practical steps toward what God has shown us, begin studying, organizing, serving, building, and preparing with whatever God has already placed in our hands. Every God-given vision will face tests, delays, criticism, and discouragement. Joseph saw his future in a dream, but he endured betrayal, slavery, and imprisonment before reaching the palace. Nehemiah also faced opposition but declared, "I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down" (Nehemiah 6:3).

We must protect the vision and refuse to allow distractions or negative voices to make us abandon our assignment.
