## *The Manifestation of God's Faithfulness and love.*

**Lamentations 3:22–23**--“Through the LORD’s mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.” One of the greatest assurances a child of God can have is the assurance that God is faithful and God is love. Life may change, people may change, situations may change, but God does not change. His faithfulness is not seasonal, and His love is not conditional. He remains dependable, compassionate, merciful, and true to His Word. The manifestation of God’s faithfulness and love means the visible proof, evidence, and demonstration of who God is in our lives. Sometimes we see it through answered prayers. Sometimes we see it through divine protection. Sometimes we see it through provision, healing, restoration, forgiveness, open doors, and peace during storms.

The faithfulness of God means He keeps His promises. The love of God means He cares for us deeply and sacrificially. When these two work together in a believer’s life, the result is hope, strength, confidence, and victory.

**1. God’s Faithfulness Is Revealed Through His Promises. Numbers 23:19** says, “God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do?” God’s Word is reliable. When God speaks, He stands by what He says. Men may promise and fail, but God cannot fail. His faithfulness means He is committed to His covenant, His Word, and His children. Abraham waited many years for the promised son, but God fulfilled His Word. Sarah laughed because the promise seemed impossible, but God proved that nothing is too hard for Him. **Genesis 21:1–2** says, “And the LORD visited Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did for Sarah as He had spoken. “This shows us that delay does not mean denial. Waiting does not mean God has forgotten. God’s promise may pass through the process of time, but His faithfulness will bring it to pass.

### **The impact on us:**

God’s faithfulness teaches us to trust Him even when we do not see immediate results. It helps us stand firm during waiting seasons. It reminds us that God’s Word is stronger than our circumstances.

### **2. God’s Love Is Revealed Through Jesus Christ**

The greatest manifestation of God’s love is found in the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ.

**John 3:16** says, “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. “God did not only say He loved us; He demonstrated it.

Love gives. Love sacrifices. Love reaches out. Love rescues. God’s love was manifested at the cross of Calvary. **Romans 5:8** says, “But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. “This is powerful because God did not wait for us to be perfect before He loved us. He loved us while we were still sinners. He loved us in our weakness. He loved us when we were lost. He loved us before we knew how to love Him back.

### **The impact on us:**

God’s love gives us assurance that we are valuable to Him. It removes fear, guilt, rejection, and condemnation. It teaches us that our identity is not based on people’s opinions, but on God’s love for us.

### **3. God’s Faithfulness Is Manifested in His Mercy Every Day.**

This means every day is a fresh opportunity to experience His goodness. There are battles God has fought for us that we did not even know about. There are dangers He protected us from that we never saw. There are mistakes He covered with mercy. There are burdens He carried when we were weak. **Psalm 103:8** says, “The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.” God’s faithfulness is seen in the fact that we are still standing. We may have gone through trials, disappointments, delays, sickness, betrayal, and spiritual battles, but we were not consumed. God preserved us.

### **The impact on us:**

His daily mercy produces gratitude. It keeps us humble. It reminds us that we are not sustained by our own strength, intelligence, money, or connections, but by the mercy of God.

### **4. God’s Love Comforts Us in Difficult Seasons**

There are times when life becomes heavy. There are seasons of tears, questions, loss, disappointment, and confusion. But even in those seasons, God’s love does not leave us.

**Isaiah 43:2** says, “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you.”

Notice that God did not say we would never pass through waters. He said when we pass through them, He will be with us. His presence is proof of His love. David understood this when he said:

**Psalm 23:4** - “Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me.” The love of God does not always remove the valley immediately, but it gives us strength to walk through it. His love brings comfort, courage, and peace.

### **The impact on us:**

God’s love helps us endure hardship without losing faith. It teaches us that we are never alone. Even when people cannot understand our pain, God is present with us.

### **5. God’s Faithfulness Restores What Was Broken**

God is faithful not only to preserve us, but also to restore us. He restores joy, peace, strength, dignity, family, purpose, and destiny.

**Joel 2:25** says, “So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten.”

The enemy may attack, time may be wasted, opportunities

may seem lost, but God is able to restore. Peter denied Jesus three times, but Jesus restored him and used him mightily in the early church.

**Luke 22:32** says, “But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren.” This is the love of God. Jesus knew Peter would fall, but He also knew Peter would rise again. God’s love does not throw us away when we fail. His faithfulness brings us back to purpose.

**The impact on us:**

God’s restoration gives us hope. It reminds us that failure is not final when we return to God. His faithfulness can turn shame into testimony and weakness into ministry.

**6. God’s Faithfulness Gives Us Confidence for the Future**

**Philippians 1:6** says, “Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.”

God does not abandon what He starts. If He began the work, He would finish it. If He opened the door, He would sustain you. If He called you, He would equip you. If He brought you this far, He would not leave you now.

My dearly beloved, God’s faithfulness removes fear of the future. It gives us courage to keep praying, keep serving, keep believing, and keep moving forward. God bless you all!!!!
