Orbit of Glory

Isaiah 60:19, states that “The sun shall no longer be your light by day, nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you; But the LORD will be to you an everlasting light, And your God your glory. This sermon reminds believers that every achievement finds its true meaning in the glory of God. It celebrates a life of faithful stewardship, emphasizing that excellence, diligence, and perseverance are acts of worship when offered to the Lord.

The message highlights that completing one assignment, such as a distinguished career or academic milestone, is not the end of God's purpose but preparation for greater Kingdom impact. Using biblical examples such as Moses, Caleb, and the Apostle John, it affirms that God continues to use His servants powerfully in every season of life.

The congregation is challenged to let God's light shine through their lives, inspiring others by faithful service, while remembering that the greatest achievement is knowing Jesus Christ, whose everlasting light gives eternal significance to every season. An orbit is the path that one object follows around another object because of a powerful force that keeps it in position.

The earth orbits the sun. The moon orbits the earth. If these heavenly bodies remain in their proper orbit, there is order, stability, balance, and continuity. In the same way, the life of a believer must revolve around God. God must be the center of our worship, our decisions, our families, our ministries, our ambitions, and our future. When a life moves outside the orbit of God, confusion enters. When a family moves outside the orbit of God, disorder develops. When a ministry moves outside the orbit of God, human ambition replaces divine purpose. But when God becomes the center of our lives, His glory becomes the light that directs us.

The Orbit of Glory is the spiritual realm in which a person, family, church, or ministry lives under the influence, direction, protection, and manifestation of God's presence. It is a life that revolves around God and reflects His glory.

GOD IS THE CENTER OF THE ORBIT OF GLORY--“For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever.”

—**Romans 11:36**

Everything begins with God, is sustained by God, and must ultimately return glory to God. The believer was never created to live independently of God. Jesus said:

“Without me ye can do nothing.”

—**John 15:5**

God must not merely be included in our lives; He must be the center of our lives.

Many people want God to bless their plans, but they do not ask whether their plans are centered on His will. They want God to enter their orbit, while God is calling them to enter His.

When Christ is at the center:

- Our decisions are governed by His Word.
- Our desires are surrendered to His will.
- Our relationships reflect His character.
- Our service is motivated by love.
- Our success gives Him glory.

Paul declared: “For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.”

Paul's life revolved around Christ. His preaching, suffering, traveling, praying, and serving were all centered on Jesus. The question is not merely, “Is God present in my life?” The question is, “Is God at the center of my life?”
