El Shaddai - - God Almighty

Genesis 17:1 -- "When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, 'I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.'"

The name El Shaddai means "God Almighty," "The All-Sufficient One," and "The God Who Is More Than Enough." It reveals God's supreme power, unlimited resources, and His ability to accomplish what is impossible with man.

God revealed Himself as El Shaddai to Abram when he was old, childless, and humanly incapable of producing the promised son. In that season of impossibility, God declared that He was Almighty and able to fulfill His covenant. As believers, we serve the same El Shaddai today.

I. El Shaddai Is the God of Unlimited Power

Jeremiah 32:27--"Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?"

Luke 1:37--"For with God nothing will be impossible."

Ephesians 3:20--"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us."

--Trust God's power above your weakness.

2 Corinthians 12:9 -- "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness."

--Depend on God's ability rather than your limitations.

Proverbs 3:5-6 -- "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding."

--Believe that God can do beyond what you can imagine.

Mark 9:23 -- "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

II. El Shaddai Is the God Who Keeps His Promises

Genesis 17:2-4--"And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly "

Numbers 23:19--"God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do?"

--Stand on God's promises even when circumstances disagree.

Romans 4:20-21 -- "He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief... being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform."

--Wait patiently because God's timing is perfect.

Habakkuk 2:3 -- "Though it tarries, wait for it; because it will surely come."

--Hold fast to God's Word.

Hebrews 10:23 -- "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful."

III. El Shaddai Is the God Who Provides More Than Enough

Philippians 4:19--"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."



Psalm 23:1--"The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want."

--Bring every need before God in prayer.

Philippians 4:6-7 -- "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication "

--Trust God to meet your needs.

Matthew 6:31-33 -- "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."

--Rest in God's sufficiency and grace.

2 Corinthians 9:8 -- "And God is able to make all grace abound toward you "

IV. El Shaddai Makes the Impossible Possible

Genesis 18:13-14--"Is anything too hard for the LORD?"

Matthew 19:26--"With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

Do not give up on situations that seem hopeless.

Romans 8:28 -- "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God."

Pray boldly for what seems impossible.

Hebrews 4:16 -- "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace..."

Expect God to intervene supernaturally.

Psalm 77:14 -- "You are the God who does wonders."

Biblical Examples:

Moses witnessed El Shaddai part the sea. (**Exodus 14:21-22**)

Hannah experienced El Shaddai opening her womb. (**1 Samuel 1:19-20**)

Daniel saw El Shaddai deliver him from lions. (**Daniel 6:22**)

Lazarus experienced resurrection power. (**John 11:43-44**)

V. El Shaddai Calls His People to Walk in Faith and Obedience

Genesis 17:1--"I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless."

Hebrews 11:6--"But without faith it is impossible to please Him."

--Walk by faith and not by sight.

2 Corinthians 5:7 -- "For we walk by faith, not by sight."

--Obey God's commands wholeheartedly.

John 14:15 -- "If you love Me, keep My commandments."

--Pursue holiness in your daily life.

1 Peter 1:15-16 -- "Be holy, for I am holy."

Remain steadfast in your relationship with God.

James 1:22 -- "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only."
