## *The God of Wonders*

A wonder is something astonishing, marvelous, and beyond natural explanation. When God steps into a situation, He does what no human being can do. The God of Wonders, He is the One who performs extraordinary acts beyond human understanding and ability. Throughout Scripture, God revealed Himself through mighty signs, miracles, and acts of divine intervention that demonstrated His power, love, and sovereignty. **Psalm 77:14** "Thou art the God that doest wonders: thou hast declared thy strength among the people." "The same God who parted the sea, raised the dead, and changed impossible situations is still at work today. He has not changed. **In Malachi 3:6** states "For I am the Lord, I change not."

### **I. The God of Wonders is All-Powerful** **Jeremiah 32:17**

"Ah Lord God! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee."

God's power has no limits. He created the universe by His word and sustains all things by His power.

Examples:

- Creation of the world (**Genesis 1:1-3**)
- The parting of the Red Sea (**Exodus 14:21-22**)
- The sun standing still (**Joshua 10:12-14**)

Whatever appears impossible in your life is an opportunity for God to reveal His wonders. Your situation may be beyond human help, but it is not beyond God's power. **Luke 1:37**-"For with God nothing shall be impossible."

### **II. The God of Wonders Makes a Way Where There is No Way--Isaiah 43:19** --"Behold, I will do a new thing, I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."

God specializes in creating opportunities where none exist.

- God opened the Red Sea for Israel (**Exodus 14:13-16**).
- He provided water from a rock (**Exodus 17:6**).
- He fed over five thousand people with five loaves and two fish (**Matthew 14:17-21**)

When doors are closed, God can open new ones. When resources are insufficient, God can multiply them. The God of Wonders is not limited by circumstances.

**Revelation 3:8** --"Behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it."



**111. The God of Wonders Increases Our Faith when we witness God's mighty acts, our confidence in Him grows. Romans 10:17** --"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." **Mark 4:39-41** records that after Jesus calmed the storm, His disciples were filled with awe and their understanding of His power deepened.

The impact of God's Wonders is that :

- We learn to trust God even in impossible situations.
- Fear gives way to faith.
- We become more confident in God's promises.

Every testimony of God's wonders becomes fuel for stronger faith.

### **IV. The God of Wonders Gives Us Hope in Difficult Seasons**

God's wonders remind us that our circumstances are not final.

**Lamentations 3:21-23**--"This I recall to my mind, therefore have, I hope. It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, they are new every morning." When Israel was trapped between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army, God made a way where there seemed to be none (**Exodus 14:13-14, 21-22**).

This impact on us is that :

- We refuse to give up during trials.
- We learn to wait on God with expectation.
- We develop perseverance and spiritual resilience.

### **V. The God of Wonders Brings Transformation**

God's wonders change people from the inside out. **2 Corinthians 5:17** --"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature."

Saul the persecutor became Paul the apostle (**Acts 9:1-20**).

This impact on us is that:

- Old habits lose their hold.
- Our minds are renewed.
- We become more like Christ in character and conduct.

**Romans 12:2** --"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind."

### **VI. The God of Wonders Gives Us Victory Over Challenges**

The Christian life is not free from battles, but we serve a God who grants victory.

**Romans 8:37** --"Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us."

Biblical Example:

David defeated Goliath not by human strength but by God's power (**1 Samuel 17:45-50**).

This Impact on us is that

- We face challenges courageously.
- We depend on God's strength rather than our own.
- We live with confidence that God is fighting for us.

## VII. The God of Wonders Teaches Us to Depend on Him-

God's wonders often occur when human resources fail. **Proverbs 3:5-6** --"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding."

The widow of Zarephath experienced supernatural provision when she obeyed God (**1 Kings 17:8-16**).

This impact on us is that

- We learn humility.
- Prayer becomes our first response instead of our last resort.
- We trust God's wisdom and timing.

My dearly beloved, the greatest wonder is not merely what God does for us, but what He does in us and through us. As Christians, we become living testimonies of His power and grace. God bless you all !!
