The Parable of the Kingdom of God.

Beloved, welcome into the presence of God in Jesus name amen. As we worship the Almighty God today, we have the certain assurance that life, great joy and pleasures will fill our heart forever in Jesus name.

Psalm 16:10-11 gave us this assurance because it says ¹⁰ "For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption." ¹¹ "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore." Beloved, the Word of God is ye and amen. No one comes into His presence and remains the same. Today, get ready to receive from Him life, fullness of joy and unimaginable pleasures in Jesus name amen.

Today, as we look at the parable of the kingdom of God, we trust God for the deep revelation of His Kingdom. The Lord Jesus in Matthew 6:9-13 taught us to pray like this "...Our Father which art in heaven. Hallowed be thy name, thy KINGDOM COME, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. ..." therefore we know that it is the will of God that His kingdom be manifested in every area of our life. More so Luke 12:32 says "Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom." God's kingdom will be established in every part of our life in Jesus name.

The Lord Jesus throughout His ministry here on earth spoke to people in parables. In order to get them to hear the message of the kingdom, He used different stories that people of that time can relate with so they can believe in Him as the Savior, understand the

will of God, and the work He was sent to do here on earth by the Father. Bible scholars put the number of parables at 38 and these include the parable of the Barren Fig Tree, Prodigal Son, Rich Man and Lazarus, Ten Virgins, Good Samaritan, Sower, Lamp Under a Bushel, Talents or Minas, Counting the Cost, Mustard Seed, Unjust Judge etc

As Jesus went about preaching the gospel of the kingdom of heaven (Mt 4:17, 23), He did not always find a receptive audience. Even where He did mighty works, some did not repent - Mt 11:20-24. Even some sought to trick Him, so they might have reason to accuse Him - Mt 12:9-14. It was for this very reason that Jesus began teaching publicly in "parables" - Mt 13:10-13

The problem Jesus faced was that many people, though they had ears to hear, their ears had become "hard of hearing" - Mt 13:14-15. We pray that He will find a receptive audience in us today in Jesus name amen.

In the book of Revelation - chapters 2 and 3, we have the letters written to the 7 Churches. These are letters to the Church today as well. One phrase/sentence that was constant in the letters was "He who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." We need to listen and hearken to the word of God because faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. God wants us to be a fruitful branch in Jesus Christ - John 15:1-5. To be fruitful however we need to be both hearers and doers of the word of God.

We pray that as we listen to the Word of God today, we will not just be hearers alone but passionate and avid doers of His Word in Jesus name amen.
