Your Choice & Decision Matter

Deuteronomy 30:19, Joshua 24:15, Proverbs 3:5-6, Romans 12:2, John 10:10.

Life is governed by choices and decisions. A choice is selecting between options, while a decision is the commitment to act on that choice. Many people make good choices in their minds but never make firm decisions to follow through. You may choose to pray, but you must decide to be consistent. You may choose holiness, but you must decide to walk away from sin. You may choose Christ, but you must decide to follow Him daily. Choices begin the process, but decisions establish direction.

That is why your choice and decision matter. Together they shape: Your destiny, your character, your spiritual growth, your fulfillment in life.

Deuteronomy 30:19--"I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore, choose life" God gives us choices, but we must make decisions that align with His will.

1. Your Choices Create Opportunities, but Your Decisions Determine Outcomes--Many people desire change, but desire alone changes nothing.

A choice says: "I want better" A decision says: "I will commit to better." **James 1:22-23** "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only" Hearing God's Word is a choice. Obeying God's Word is a decision.

Galatians 6:7--"Whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." Every decision is a seed. Every seed produces a harvest. Decisions produce consequences, Decisions produce habits, Decisions produce destinies

2. Godly Choices and Decisions Separate the Ordinary from the Extraordinary--Many Christians remain spiritually average because they make ordinary decisions.

Ordinary decisions choose: Comfort over sacrifice, Entertainment over prayer, Popularity over holiness, Excuses over commitment

But extraordinary believers make intentional godly decisions. **Romans 12:2**--"Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind..."

Transformation requires both: The choice to change, The decision to live differently

Extraordinary Christians decide to:

- Pray when tired
- Worship during trials
- Remain faithful when pressured
- Trust God when situations are uncertain

Daniel Made a Defining Decision--**Daniel 1:8**--"But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself" Daniel did not merely admire holiness, he decided to be holy and live it. That one decision separated him from everyone else in Babylon.

Because of his decision:

- He gained favor
- He gained wisdom
- He gained influence
- He became extraordinary--One godly decision can change your life forever.

3. Choosing God Leads to Fulfillment

Joshua 24:15- "Choose you this day whom ye will serve, but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Joshua made both a choice and a decision. He chose God.

He decided to serve Him completely. Many people choose God emotionally but never decide to surrender fully. True fulfillment comes when our decisions match our confession.

Psalms 16:11"In thy presence is fulness of joy" The fulfilled life is found in: God's presence, God's will, God's purpose.

John 10:10b-"I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." Jesus came to give abundant life, but abundant life requires intentional spiritual decisions.

4. Wrong Choices and Decisions Can Damage Destiny

Proverbs 14:12--"There is a way which seems right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." Not every decision that feels good is good. Many people make decisions based on: Feelings, Pressure, Temporary pleasure and public opinion. Believers must make decisions based on God's truth and direction.

5. Wise Decisions Require Seeking God

Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and he shall direct thy paths. "Good decisions require divine direction. Before making major decisions, the bible states this in **James 1:5**- "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God" Some decisions are too important to make emotionally, for example in the aspect of marriage.

6. Your decisions reveal your priorities and affect future Generation:

Matthew 6:33- “Seek ye first the kingdom of God”

Deuteronomy 5:29” that it might be well with them, and with their children forever!”
