Your Choice & Decision Matter

Part 2

Every choice carries a consequence, and every decision produces an outcome. God has given mankind the power to choose, but He also teaches us that our choices determine whether we experience blessing or sorrow, progress or delay, fulfillment or regret.

1. The Advantages of Godly Choices and Decisions

A. Godly Choices Bring Divine Direction

Proverbs 3:5-6--"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." One major advantage of choosing God is divine direction. When we seek God before making decisions:

- God orders our steps
- God protects us from unnecessary mistakes
- God opens the right doors

Psalm 37:23--"The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delights in his way."

Genesis 12:1--"Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, unto a land that I will shew thee." Abraham's decision to obey God connected him to covenant blessings and destiny.

B. Godly Choices Bring Peace

Isaiah 26:3--"Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusts in thee."

One advantage of right decisions is peace of mind--
When your decisions align with God:

- Your conscience remains clear
- Fear loses its power
- Your heart gains stability

Philippians 4:7--"And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Sin may bring temporary pleasure, but righteousness brings lasting peace.

C. Godly Choices Bring Favor and Promotion

Deuteronomy 28:1"And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth."

Obedience positions believers for divine favor.

Daniel's Decision Brought Promotion--**Daniel 1:8** "But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself" Daniel chose holiness in a corrupt environment. Because of his decision:

- He received wisdom
- He received favor
- He received promotion
- He became extraordinary

Daniel 1:20"And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, he found them ten times better" Godly decisions separate the ordinary from the extraordinary.

D. Godly Choices Build Strong Generations

Deuteronomy 5:29--"O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, that it might be well with them, and with their children forever"

Your choices affect your family and future generations.

Advantages of righteous decisions include:

- Godly legacy
- Spiritual inheritance
- Stable homes
- Generational blessings

Joshua 24:15--"As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Joshua's decision influenced his household.

E. Godly Choices Produce Fulfillment

John 10:10--"I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. "True fulfillment comes from living according to God's purpose.

Psalm 16:11"In thy presence is fulness of joy" The world offers temporary satisfaction, but Christ offers abundant life.

2. The Disadvantages of Wrong Choices and Decisions

A. Wrong Decisions Bring Regret

Proverbs 14:12--"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."

Not every attractive opportunity is from God. Wrong choices may feel good temporarily but eventually produce pain.

The Prodigal Son--**Luke 15:13-14**"he wasted his substance with riotous living. And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine"

The disadvantages of his decisions included:

- Poverty
- Shame
- Isolation
- Emptiness

B--Sin always takes people farther than they intended to go. Wrong Decisions Delay Destiny. The Israelites faces the consequences in the wilderness.

Numbers 14:33--“And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years” Fear and unbelief delayed Israel’s progress. An eleven-day journey became forty years because of wrong decisions.

Wrong choices can delay:

- Spiritual growth
- Ministry progress
- Family restoration
- Divine opportunities

C. Wrong Decisions Bring Bondage

John 8:34--“Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.” Many bondages begin with one wrong decision:

- One compromise
- One sinful relationship
