- > <u>LEGION</u> = Honorably Discharged or Still Serving Veterans with at least 1 Day of Active-Duty during these periods:
  - \*\* April 6, 1917 to Nov. 11, 1918 (WW-I)
  - \*\* Dec. 7, 1941 to Present !!
- ~ Need DD-214 = All New Members & Transfers
- > <u>SONS</u> = Male descendants, including stepsons and adopted sons, of a Current Legion Member or a QUALIFIED Deceased Veteran who was "Eligible" for membership.
- > <u>AUXILIARY</u> = Mother, wife, daughter, sister, granddaughter, great-granddaughter, or grandmother of a Current Legion Member or a QUALIFIED Deceased Veteran who was "Eligible" for membership.
- ~ Need DD-214 = All New Members & Transfers Except those eligibile via Post-1450 Member
