Annual Corporation Meeting June 3, 2021

As required by ARTICLE IX of the Bylaws of Mohawk Post #1450, Inc. (as amended) the annual Corporation Meeting will take place on Thursday, June 3, 2021 at 7:30pm. You must be a Paid-Up member for the year 2021 to attend the annual Corporation meeting and you must present your paid membership card for 2021 at the door.

- ** "Term Extensions" caused by the COVID-19 Virus require the following seats on the Board of Directors will be filled:
- ** <u>Four, One-Year terms</u> The new terms will expire in 2022 and are currently being held by **Doug Ludwig, Sam Gallucci**, **Greg Mincher**, and **Jimmy Johnson**.
- ** <u>Four, Two-Year terms</u>- The new terms will expire in 2023 and are presently held by **Gil Lebel, Jimmy Oooo, Roy Kraus & Mike Knise.**
- ** One, Three-Year term- The new term will expire in 2024 and is presently held by Jim Keith.
- **One, Three-Year term which will expire in 2025 and is currently being held by **Bob Malo**.
- ** <u>Note</u>: "Automatic-Seats" on the Board include the current Post Commander, Immediate Past Commander, Adjutant, and Finance Officer.
- ** All members of Mohawk Post #1450 are automatically members of the Corporation; and as such are eligible to vote if their dues are paid-up for the current membership year to elect the Board of Directors to govern the Corporation for the coming year.


