

- \*\* <u>Two, Two-Year terms</u>- The new terms will expire in 2026 and are presently held by **Gil Lebel & Sam Gallucci.**
- \*\* One, Three-Year term- The new term will expire in 2027 and is presently held by **Kevin A. Walsh**.
- \*\* **Note**: "Automatic-Seats" on the Board include the current Post Commander, Immediate Past Commander, Adjutant, and Finance Officer.



- \*\* DD-214 Required for All New Members & Transfers Except those who Derive eligibility via a Past or Present Post-1450 Member
