**Administrators Message** 

First, I want to wish everyone a very Happy New Year. I hope each of you had a very nice holiday season.

I can't believe 2023 is finally here. While I would like to say this year flew by, that was not the case for me this year. This was a full year of getting my sea legs as Administrator of the lodge. Trying to figure out my own way and get a process that worked not only for myself but all our wonderful volunteers that keep the lodge running smoothly and of course our members. With the help of a great board for both the lodge and WOTM and amazing volunteers we have had some memorable successes this year. We had a lot of fun events, we had Casino Nights, Horseraces, St. Patty's Day Dinner, Friendsgiving, Tom & Jerry, Poker, Karaoke, Cornhole and many more things. We tried some things for the first time like a trunk or treat for Halloween opening it up to the whole community. We did a lot of community service efforts in fact. We had a Memorial Day Event at the lodge, we filled goodie bags for veterans. We hosted a casino night for a young CVHS student to help her raise money for travel expenses while battling cancer. Most recently assisting with ensuring a junior at CVHS could go to an elite football camp so the scouts could see him play and he can improve his game. So while we like to have parties and do a lot of fun stuff we do a lot of good at the same time as well. While the fun stuff is great, the last few things I mentioned are the things that keep me motivated.

We had amazing membership numbers in 2022 signing a whopping 389 new members with more applications already turned in ready to go in the first week of January at our next meeting. We have surpassed 1000 members and are currently sitting at 1078 active members as I write this message.

The biggest item that I'm excited about is that we were able to refinance our building. As some of you may have known, our balloon payment would have been due on January 20, 2023, in the amount of approximately \$522,000. As you can imagine we did not have that kind of cash just laying around to pay off this amount. After going to multiple banks and lenders we ended up getting a loan from Moose International in the amount of \$550,000. The extra money loaned to us will go specifically to paying the roof. In fact, Moose International will hold on to that extra money until it comes time to pay for the roof then they will cut us a check so no worries on that money getting spent on other items that come up. Based on the last report we ran we have raised over 16K towards the roof since August of 2021, so we are well on our way to hitting our goal. If you have any ideas on how to raise money to help us get to the finish line of approximately 60K please feel free to share and lend a hand.

Remember we cannot and will not be successful without our members' support. So please continue to come to our events and help when you are available. When they said it takes a village they were not kidding. See you at the lodge
