Membership Report

Your Lodge is presently at about 1,497 members, which is down just 1 for the year. That's OK. We still have lots of time. We have JUST SHY of an 85% retention rate, which is REALLY good! We currently have 234 expired members and 195 dropped members, **which isn't at all unusual for us**, but it means ***we have some work to do.***

Deputies **UNITE!**

Everyone reading this is likely a sponsor of a Moose Member, I am sure. Everyone reading this room is probably a sponsor of a member whose dues have expired.

Voila! You're part of the membership committee!

Together, let's make plans to reach out to them and find out why they've let their dues expire. My experience is that they've simply forgotten, or for some silly reason, they want to make the renewal process harder than it really is.

It's hard for me to reach out to 450 members each month, so I'm asking for your help.

I've put up renewal QR codes in the social quarters for those that come into the Lodge with an expired card, but I need your help with those that don't come back in at all. Let's work on that together, OK?

In the meantime, if you've sponsored someone that didn't renew, give them a shout to see what's up. Every sponsor of an expired member gets a letter from Moose International with the contact info of the expired members, so it's easy to reach out to them.

We just gotta wanna.

Next.... Our NEW member application goal for the year is 260. While that may sound like a lot, we're already at 88, which is 34% of the goal. We're literally only 25% into the new Moose year! Time to celebrate? No, not yet. But we're ahead, and we usually are by this time.

We're incredibly good at getting folks to join. We just need to work a little harder on keeping them.

Our Lodge is an AWESOME Lodge. We've proven this time and again. We can be even **AWESOMER** (I know....

It's **NOT** a word) but if we can just reach out to those we've lost along the way and extend another welcoming hand... A hug... An ***"I miss you"***.
