We had 16 teams playing in our **Monday Night Novice** League. A strong Novice league is the basis for all of our other leagues to grow on.

Tuesday Night Ladies had a strong group of 10 teams. We are expecting a couple of the novice teams to come in and fill two spots to make 12 teams in the league.

Wednesday Night Men started the season with 9 teams but as the season progressed, we saw the league grow to 12 teams.

Our **Special O program** was once again full of six sheets of curlers each Saturday.

Our **junior program** grew over the year to number over 20 curlers on Thursday afternoon and Saturday morning.

Our “learn to curl” program was hugely successful this year. We had three 5-week sessions. Many of these new curlers graduated into the Monday Night Novice league or Sunday Night Social leagues. For next season look for a continuation of the Learn-2-Curl program with the addition of Junior and Senior Learn-2-Curl programs.
