Enrollment Process:

1. Submit the following to First Lutheran Classical School:
 - a. Completed enrollment application form
 - b. \$50.00 non-refundable application fee (per student)
 - c. Copy of each student's birth certificate
 - d. Copies of last two years' report cards
 - e. Copies of any standardized test results
 - f. Record of coursework/curricula if homeschooled
 - g. Results of specialized tests/evaluations which impact school performance/behavior
2. Participate in a parent interview to be scheduled once all documents listed above are received. Students applying for grades seven and above are required to attend an admissions interview also.
3. Students may be required to complete entrance testing to determine kindergarten readiness or grade placement. This will be scheduled in conjunction with the parent interview.
4. You will receive written notification of admission status once all of the above steps have been completed.
5. Enrollment and book fees are due upon admission. Your admission letter will detail the exact amount of each fee as this is dependent upon grade level.

6. The following must be submitted before a student is considered enrolled and able to attend classes:
 - a. All fees must be paid
 - b. A signed tuition payment commitment (if tuition is not paid in advance)
 - c. A copy of each student's immunization record/CIS exemption form
 - d. Completed 3-in-1 Form (Field trip permission, Handbook pledge, and Health & Accident Release)
 - e. Student and at least one parent/guardian attend orientation as scheduled before the beginning of the school year or arrange a meeting with the principal in advance of orientation date (if enrolling after the start of the school year this must occur before the student may attend class).
