- Fishing (net setting, filleting, cleaning)
- Duck hunting and firearm safety
- Mental health and cultural wellness practices
- Traditional cooking and cleaning after sessions
- Outdoor safety and guiding students
- Language and cultural development
- Community-based land learning practices

- Educators and youth workers
- Hunters, fishers, and land stewards
- Anyone with a passion for sharing Indigenous knowledge and supporting students
