

# Anglican Catechist Training School ACTS Year 2 2024-2025



### **Licensing: Catechist II License - Lay Pastoral Catechist**

Building upon the foundation laid in ACTS year 1, the candidate receives more in-depth training to assist in providing teach the doctrines of the Christian faith as outlined in the ACNA Catechism as well as is equipped to serve as pastoral support alongside clergy and to engage in planting congregations within the Anglican Diocese of San Joaquin.

# **Goals for ACTS 2**

- 1. Develop a biblically informed ecclesiology rooted in catholicity.
- 2. Deepen theological understanding of the Book of Common Prayer, the sacraments, and the sacramental life.
- 3. Develop a foundation for pastoral ministry and be able to use the Prayer Book and other resources in assisting clergy in pastoral and liturgical ministries, such as praying for healing, serving at the altar, or leading the Daily Office.
- 4. Continue to become familiar with various pedagogical approaches and strategies for teaching adults and children.
- 5. Be able to assist the rector in building up the congregation through weekend renewal retreats or by developing outreach to the community.
- 6. Continue to engage in spiritually formative practices that lead to spiritual *and* emotional maturity.
- 7. Continue to grow as a disciple and leader in God's Church, learning to hear God's voice and in faith follow his leading to engage in ministry beyond one's comfort
- 8. Equip leaders to plant churches.
- 9. Equip lay people to come alongside the clergy in assisting with parish ministry.

Cost: \$400 for the year (Can be paid by module.)

# **Content of Year 2 Training**

- Independent Study with 11 online meetings with ACTS Instructors.
- Completion of monthly Spiritual Formation Mentor reflection and mentor meetings with priest.
- Study and practicum for the various licenses (LEM. PLEM and Lay Reader) independently and with one's clergy (priest or deacon).

- Daily and weekly engagement in spiritual formation disciplines (praying the Daily Office, engaging in contemplative prayer practices, meeting with a spiritual director, etc.) in order to be spiritually formed in a wholistic manner as a disciple of Christ
- Deepening of biblical and theological knowledge through discussion, reading and responding to assigned readings and videos.

# **Three Dimensions**

- 1. Developing **Dogma**
- 2. **Praxis & Leadership Development**—to be done with clergy (includes teaching, preaching, serving at the altar, leading the Daily Office, pastoral care, shadowing the priest, etc.
- 3. **Spiritual Formation**—mentoring and spiritual disciplines such as the Daily Office, confession, and ancient prayer practices
