

Loretta Veney Inspires! Puzzles & Fidgets Toys

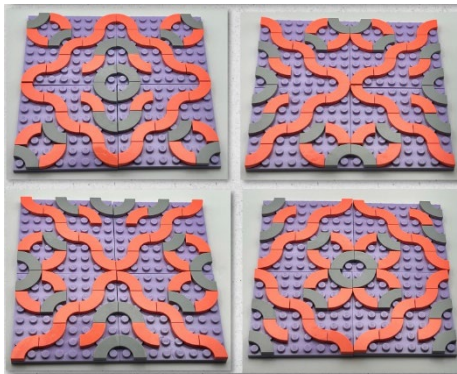
Thank you for purchasing a Puzzle made with LEGO® bricks!

These two and four piece puzzles are fun for everyone, but have been designed especially for seniors, including those with cognitive decline! Loretta's Mom Doris had dementia for 16 years and absolutely loved engaging with these puzzles. When the pieces are moved around, the design changes into different patterns (from 4-8 patterns per puzzle) resulting in great engagement and lots of Joy!

PUZZLES



Remove the two or four pieces from the bag and then move the pieces around to form different patterns / configurations. The photos provide examples of how the designs change as the pieces are moved, but there is no right or wrong way to use the puzzles. The goal is to engage with the pieces and have fun!

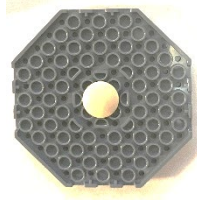
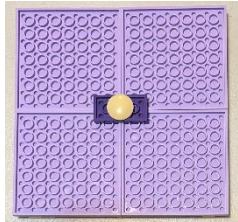


ROTATING FIDGETS

Each fun fidget is made from two identical turntables that turn in both directions. They can be used just to keep hands and minds busy or to match up the patterns on each fidget. They are great anxiety-relievers!



SPINNERS



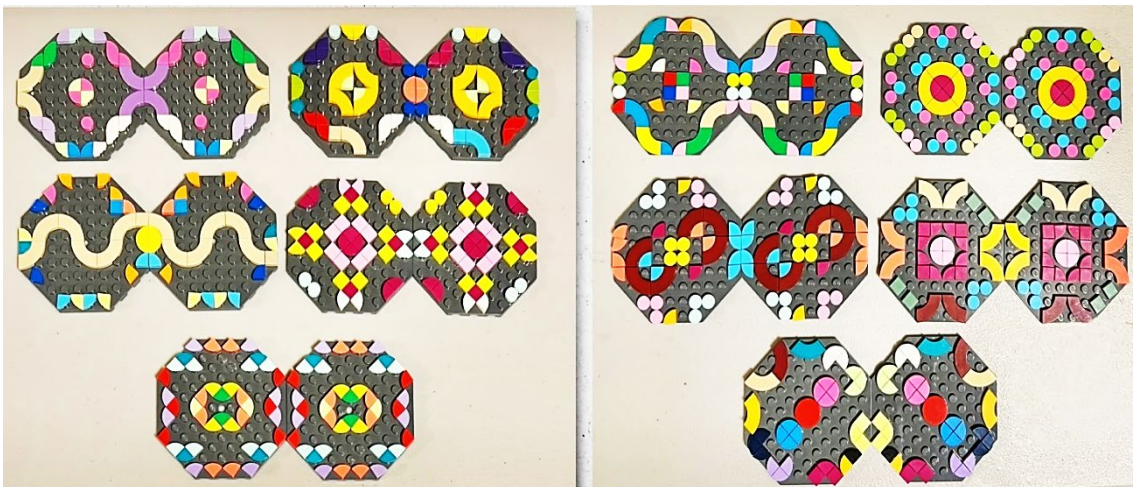
Each puzzle comes with a small round piece that when placed on the back of the puzzle allows it to spin! After attaching the spinner in the middle of the back of the

puzzle, place it on a flat surface and spin the puzzle in either direction to watch the magic happen.

MEMORY MATCH GAME

The game comes in sets of 10 or 20 pieces containing 5 or 10 pairs of matching octagons. To start the game, turn all the octagons over (design side down). Selecting one octagon at a time, try to find its match from the remaining pieces by remembering where the match is located. When the match isn't found, turn both pieces back over and continue to turn the pieces over one at a time until all the matching pairs have been found. How great is your memory?

For those with middle to late stage dementia, the octagons can be left face up on a table and mixed around making it much easier to find the matching piece! The level of joy interacting with the octagons remains the same.



Warning!!! The puzzle LEGO pieces called DOTS are very small and could be a choking hazard and are not intended for small children or those with late stage cognitive issues! Those with cognitive issues should not be left unsupervised with the puzzles.
