## **Bible Lesson: Daniel Was Rescued from the Lions**

This week we are learning a well-known story from the Bible usually called Daniel and the Lion's Den. The story is found in **Daniel, Chapter 6 of your Bible. Please read it!**

The story has many lessons that we can learn. At that time, King Darius was in charge and Daniel had continued to serve and grow in his responsibilities. The King, like any government, had officials, supervisors and these people called "satraps" that gave the King advice. In the story, we learn how the King's advisors wanted to catch Daniel doing something wrong. Partly, they were jealous of Daniel's position.

**Daniel 6:5 says, "Then these men said, "We shall not find any ground for complaint against this Daniel unless we find it in connection with the law of his God." MEMORY VERSE**

This verse shows the King's supervisors thinking about Daniel but understanding that Daniel could only be found doing something wrong, if it involved Daniel's God – or praying.

**STORY IDEA:** One lesson from this story reminds us that everything we do could change how the people around us think about us. What are you known by? Do you dance, sing, play sports? All those things are wonderful gifts from God, but one of our prayers should be that God would change our heart and allow us to act in a way for those around us to know that we know about God, that we believe in Jesus as our Savior and that we are looking forward to our time with Jesus in heaven much more than those daily worries in our life right now! That's what Daniel shows us!

The King's supervisor's got King Darius to pass a law that everyone had to pray ONLY to the King. The officials knew that Daniel would not obey the law! It was all a big trick!

Daniel prayed to God three times a day and the men saw Daniel and told the King. Even though the King didn't want to, he had to obey the law he made. The penalty for breaking the new law was to be thrown into the Lion's Den and be eaten alive! Daniel was thrown into the Lion's Den, but God shut the Lion's mouth. This was a miracle, showing God's faithfulness to Daniel and His Power! God rescued Daniel and he made a way to rescue us from our sin! God sent His Son Jesus, to come to earth and live a sinless life, but to die in our place, for our sin! And then Jesus was raised from the dead and now lives and has conquered death!

**God invites us to believe in Jesus as our Savior.** Without a Savior, we will be judged for our sin and then be put into Hell and required to live forever! Jesus can make our sin "white as snow" and He promises a relationship that will allow us to live with him even after we die from our bodies in this world! Believe in Him today!
