This week, we learn of a time where Jesus and his disciples were on a hillside and Jesus performed a miracle.

At the top of the page, we provide the scripture where the story is found in all 4 of the Gospels. Please take time to try and look the scripture up and read it.

The story tells of the time where Jesus was becoming more known and popular in the area. Jesus was healing the sick and teaching on the day of the story. It was later in the day and the Disciples were beginning to discuss whether to have the crowd leave or how they would be able to feed them. **The scripture tells us that over 5,000 people were around them.**

The scriptures tell of a boy with 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish. Jesus gets the food the boy has and says a blessing to God. They begin to give the food out and everyone gets enough food to be full and they have 12 baskets left over!

God knows our needs and has compassion for us! God provides for our needs!

Be sure to thank God for providing for you!

But Jesus also wanted the people to know (and for us to know), that believing in HIM gives us "bread of life", not just the type of bread that grows old.

Be sure that we aren't missing the Jesus and eternal life just because we are worried about today's bread!
