E-Nose and Live Vision to catch Graffiti Vandals*

New trials of sniffing technology (E-Nose Pty Ltd) and surveillance CCTV have been established in southern and western Sydney.

By combining the technologies, the property managers can check the site visually after receiving an alert from the paint sniffer. An SMS alerts the appropriate authority who immediately uses a smart-phone to receive a stream of live video from one or several cameras at the attack site. The cameras are not easy to see by the vandals and the E-Nose device is completely hidden.


Alarm verification is favoured by police forces to conserve resources. The combined

technologies also provide better evidence to be presented when the vandal is brought to court. Many vandals spend sufficient time at an attack site, to make them very likely to be arrested in the act. Vandals are now unable to commit their costly and destructive acts with impunity.
