Facilitation & Instruction

- Lead hands-on training in areas such as:

 - Hygiene and self-presentation

- Shelf stocking, time management, and public transit use
- Adapt sessions to meet individual learning styles and needs
- Foster a respectful, inclusive, and empowering learning environment

Café Simulation Support

- Supervise and guide participants during Saturday café operations
- Support roles including food and beverage prep, client service, and workspace cleaning
- Encourage participation from families, friends, and community members

Assessment & Collaboration

- Observe and document participant progress
- Assist with skill assessments and readiness evaluations
- Collaborate with job coaches, house managers, volunteers and other program staff

- Ability to model workplace routines and positive behavior
- Comfortable with basic cooking, cleaning, and customer service tasks
