




Bell Research Laboratory Code Validation Criteria

To validate a theological belief, all aspects of the belief must pass a three level consistency check.


Each validation stages' inputs and findings are checked for associations and/or relationship inconsistencies with the following sources:


- 1. The Holy Bible
- 2. The Spirit of Prophecy (Ellen G. White's prophetic writings, etc...)
- 3. Valid Bible code matrices
 If all three criteria are met, without
 violation, the theological belief is considered
 valid and adopted as present truth.

Revelation 14:6 and 7 (Peshitta) (God's final message to mankind is a call to worship the Creator.)




"8Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. 9Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: 10But the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: 11For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it." Exodus 20:8 – 11 (KJV) (We worship Him as the Creator by keeping His Sabbath.)

Genesis 2:1 – 3 (KJV) (The Sabbath was set apart at creation. God rested upon the seventh day, blessed the seventh day and hallowed it.)


"27And he said to them, 'The Sabbath was created for the sake of man and not man for the sake of the Sabbath.' 28'Therefore The Son of Man is also master of the Sabbath." Mark 2:27 & 28 (Peshitta) (The Sabbath was given to the human race 2300 years before the existence of the Jews as a memorial for all mankind.)

"Now pray, so that your flight will not be in the winter, nor on the Sabbath." Matthew 24:20 (Peshitta) (Jesus predicted the Sabbath would be kept in 70 A.D. at the destruction of Jerusalem over 35 years after His death.)


"42 And while they were leaving their presence, they begged them that on the next Sabbath they would speak to them these words. 43 And after the synagogue was dismissed, many Judeans followed them and also proselytes who feared God. And they were speaking and persuading them to be follower[s] of the grace of God. 44 And on the next Sabbath [day], the whole city was gathered to hear the word of God." Acts 13:42 – 44 (Peshitta) (Paul both kept the Sabbath himself and met to worship God with the whole city, Jews and Gentiles alike.)





"54And it was the preparation day and the Sabbath was dawning. 55And the women who had come with him from Galilee were near and they saw the grave and how his body had been placed. 56And they returned and prepared spices and ointments and rested on the Sabbath as was commanded. 1Now on the first day of the week, at dawn while it was dark, they came to the tomb and brought the spices they had prepared, and there were with them other women." Luke 23:54 – 56; 24:1 (Peshitta) (This passage lists three days in succession. The day Christ died--the preparation--Friday. The day Jesus rested in the tomb--Sabbath--Saturday. The day Jesus resurrected--the first day--Sunday. The Sabbath is clearly Saturday, the seventh day of the week.)



9Therefore, it is established for the people of God to be given a rest. 10For he who enters into his rest has also rested from his works, as God rested from his." Hebrews 4:4-10 (Peshitta) (The day of rest is the seventh day Sabbath. If there was another or different day, Jesus would have mentioned it.)





Sister White's Comments on The Sabbath

"The importance of the Sabbath as the memorial of creation is that it keeps ever present the true reason why worship is due to God,' because he is the Creator, and we his creatures. 'The Sabbath therefore lies at the very foundation of divine worship; for it teaches this great truth in the most impressive manner, and no other institution does this. The true ground of divine worship, not of that on the seventh day merely, but of all worship, is found in the distinction between the Creator and his creatures. This great fact can never become obsolete, and must never be forgotten.' It was to keep this truth ever before the minds of men, that God instituted the Sabbath in Eden; and so long as the fact that he is our Creator continues to be a reason why we should worship him, so long the Sabbath will continue as its sign and memorial. Sister White's Comments on The Sabbath (Cont.)

Had the Sabbath been universally kept, man's thoughts and affections would have been led to the Creator as the object of reverence and worship, and there would never have been an idolater, an atheist, or an infidel. The keeping of the Sabbath is a sign of loyalty to the true God, 'him that made heaven and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.' It follows that the message which commands men to worship God and keep his commandments, will especially call upon them to keep the fourth commandment."-*The Great Controversy (1888)*, pages 437 and 438.


Sister White's Comments on The Sabbath (Cont.)





Sister White's Comments on The Sabbath (Cont.)


The [RED] STR codes reveal:

- 1) There will be a special group of people (Team144K) within the vast group of all those that are found worthy to enter the heavenly community.
- 2) At a specific time, the Holy Spirit will provide special powers to these individuals. Both physical (there faces will glow) and mental (prophecy) light (i.e. insight) will be provided to them.

- 4) that these individuals will perform the last great work of God to execute the Loud Cry to everyone on the earth.




The [RED] STR codes reveal (cont.):
