Bell Research Laboratory Viewpoint Validation Criteria


To validate a theological belief, all aspects of the belief must pass a three-level consistency check.

Each validation stages' inputs and findings are checked for associations and/or relationship inconsistencies with the following sources:


- 1. The Holy Bible

- 3. Valid Bible code matrices


 If all three criteria are met, without


View Validation Criteria






- •"11These things Jesus said and afterward he said to them, 'Lazarus, our friend, sleeps, but I am going to wake him.' 12His disciples said to him, 'Our Lord, if he sleeps, he will be healed.' 13But Jesus spoke about his death, yet they thought that he spoke about sleeping on a bed. 14Then Jesus said to them plainly, 'Lazarus has died.'" John 11:11 14 (Peshitta) (Jesus compares death to sleep. The Bible compares death to sleep over 50 times.)
- •"15Now this we say to you, by the word of our Lord, that we who remain at the coming of our Lord who are living will not overtake those who are asleep, 16because our Lord, with a command and with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, will come down from heaven and the dead who are in Christ will rise up first." 1 Thessalonians 4:15 & 16 (Peshitta) (Those asleep in Jesus rise at His Second Coming.)


- •"28Now because he is the Son of Man, do not marvel at this, because the hour will come when all those who are in the graves will hear his voice. 29And those who have done good things will go out to the resurrection of life and those who have done evil things to the resurrection of judgment." John 5:28 & 29 (Peshitta) (Some are resurrected to eternal life, and others to eternal death/damnation.)
- •"And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." Genesis 2:7 (KJV) (God created man out of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul. God did not put a soul into man.)





•"51 Behold, I am telling you a mystery. Note that the "last trump" announces the return of Jesus and is not the same as the seventh trumpet warning of Revelation 10:7.)


- •"The dead praise not the Lord, neither any that go down into silence." Psalms 115:17 (KJV) (The dead do not praise God.)
- •"12So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep. 13O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!" Job 14:12 & 13 (KJV) (When someone dies, they are not resurrected until God remembers and calls them.)



- •"For David did not ascend into heaven, because he said, The Lord said to my Lord, sit at my right hand" Acts 2:34 (Peshitta) (David did not ascend to heaven at death, but awaited the coming of Jesus and the first resurrection.)
- •"For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks?" Psalms 6:5 (KJV) (In the grave there is no remembrance of God.)
- •"For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten." Ecclesiastes 9:5 (KJV) (The dead do not know anything.)










Ellen G. White Comments on The State of the Dead



Ellen G. White Comments on The State of the Dead (Cont.)

"I saw that the saints must get a thorough understanding of present truth, which they will be obliged to maintain from the Scriptures. They must understand the state of the dead; for the spirits of devils will yet appear to them, professing to be beloved friends and relatives, who will declare to them that the Sabbath has been changed, also other unscriptural doctrines. They will do all in their power to excite sympathy and will work miracles before them to confirm what they declare. The people of God must be prepared to withstand these spirits with the Bible truth that the dead know not anything, and that they who appear to them are the spirits of devils. Our minds must not be taken up with things around us, but must be occupied with the present truth and a preparation to give a reason of our hope with meekness and fear. We must seek wisdom from on high that we may stand in this day of error and delusion."-*Early Writings*, (1882), pages 87 & 88.






Ellen G. White Comments on The Second Death (Cont.)




Ellen G. White Comments on The Second Death (Cont.)






To View the STR Code Interpretations

To view the Surface Text Relevancy (STR) code interpretations, be sure to set the view of the PowerPoint presentation as follows: Click the "View" tab and then "Normal".

The text boxes (main window) are reviewed one by one in the direction of the "STR Codes" arrow and shown in numerical order in the slide notes area. The notes pane should be seen at the bottom of the slides as well as a thumbnail of each of the slides on the left-hand side of the PowerPoint window. You can drag the top of the slide notes window edge to adjust the size of it. A screen shot of what you should see is shown below:




(immortality of the soul)

This Code matrix was inspired by a discussion regarding the "immortality of the soul". The matrix discoverer looked in the Tanakh for the expression "immortality of the soul" (10 letters in Hebrew, if one uses the shorter spelling). Amazing Bible Codes (ABC) Decoder indicated 0 occurrences were expected and 1 was actually found. The phrase was not extendable but 2 interesting terms exist adjacent to it on the same string of letters, running exactly parallel and separated by 5 letters, "an error" and "a deceit yes".




The [RED] STR codes reveal:

- 1) The Lord says that the righteous will have joy, gladness, and wonderful parties. To receive this, love the truth and peace.

The [RED] STR codes reveal (cont.):

- 5) The saints love the Lord and His law is in their hearts.

- 8) When we are obedient to God, He will direct the paths of our lives.




The [RED] STR codes reveal (cont.):

- 10) The work that the chosen ones do will spread to the middle east and will cause much tribulation.


The [BLUE] STR codes reveal:

- 7) those that are willing to perform service to the Lord.






The Bible code matrix discoverer, said that he used the Hebrew spelling found in Franz Delitzsch's version in Revelation 20:14.

The longest, and most interesting one, was found in the Aramaic New Testament (NT) also known as the Peshitta. 8 occurrences were expected and 8 were found. The lowest skip was extendable to the phrase "from God; be deeply grieved about the second death" which crosses several interesting surface texts that discuss relevant topics (STR codes).
