Short Term Rental Rules

AS PER MUNICIPALITY OF LAMBTON SHORES

Maximum occupancy of 10 adults (ages 13 and older). Children 12 and younger are not included in the occupancy limit.

Proper disposal of garbage and recycling must occur.

Compliance with Noise Bylaw: No noise between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Compliance with Fireworks Bylaw: No discharging of family and prohibited fireworks.

Failure to comply will result in eviction and no refund.



The kitchen is equipped with all utensils, flatware, and cookware. Cleaning supplies are located underneath the kitchen sink.

Complimentary coffee is provided.

If anything is missing, running out or not working properly, please report it.

Garbage/Recycling

Upon Checkout, please bag and remove all garbage and recycling from the cottage and place it in the appropriate bins in the driveway.

The black bin is for garbage and the blue bin is for recycling. Please break down all recycling.

Garbage and recycling pickup day is Tuesday morning. The bins must be placed at the road Monday evening, no earlier then 5p.m.

Air Conditioning/Heat

The thermostat is located in the hallway upstairs.

A reasonable temperature is between 66 to 72 degrees Fahrenheit.

The downstairs bedroom has a baseboard heater and the thermostat is located behind the dresser mirror.

Adjust the temperature as you please.

DO NOT turn the heat on during the summer

DO NOT turn the A/C on during the winter.

DO NOT open the windows while A/C or heat is on.

Fireplace

To turn on the fireplace, set the thermostat on the left side of the fireplace to your desired temperature. The fireplace will turn on when the room drops below this set temperature.

What is Provided



Each bed has a fitted sheet, flat sheet, quilt, four pillows and pillow cases



The kitchen is equipped with a fridge, freezer, stove, oven, microwave, dishwasher, coffee machine, toaster, crockpot, utensils, flatware, cooking utensils, etc.



An equivalent number of shower towels to the number of people stated on the booking (up to 12 towels), two hand towels, and two kitchen/dish towels



Propane for the BBQ



Turn off all lights




Ensure the property is tidy and free of litter
