

## WHAT ARE PANS AND PANDAS?

Pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome (PANS) and pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections (PANDAS) are neuroimmune disorders that produce devastating, life-altering symptoms in children and young adults. Patients may endure severe OCD, tics, joint pain, gastrointestinal distress, extreme sleep disturbance, separation anxiety, disordered eating, aggression, irritability, emotional lability and more as a result of immune system dysfunction.

- Many PANS and PANDAS patients also are diagnosed with POTS.
- Researchers at Stanford found children with PANS have an increased risk of developing arthritis and other autoimmune diseases compared with the general pediatric population, particularly enthesitis-related arthritis.¹

At age 11 Lulu's life changed overnight following a strep infection. On January 2, 2019, she awoke with a different body and mind that she no longer controlled.
