Requirements for Installation of:

Alternative Heating/Cooling Systems

The guidelines are listed for any member of the PEVHOA contemplating the addition of the new alternative heating/cooling systems now available on the open market. Any homeowner, that has not received approval from the Board prior to installation, must also adhere to these guidelines.

Pre-approval:

- 1. Only licensed contractors will be considered.
- 2. Owner will contact the PEVHOA Architectural Committee (AC) with written plans for approval. This must contain selected contractor(s) to be used for the project.
- 3. All projects will require approval of the AC that may require a minimum of thirty days for review.
- 4. Once approval is granted, proof of a Plumas County permit must be submitted to the AC BEFORE work can begin.

Scope of compliance:

- 5. All outside units will be placed on a stand in order to not be compromised by snow accumulation. The Association will not cover any damages to units from snow removal.
- 6. It is recommended that all outside pipes be installed under the crawl space.
- 7. Any outside pipes must be incased and painted to match siding or trim.
- 8. Any drainage pipes to be encased and painted to match siding or trim.
- 9. Outside units should be placed where they are not in direct view of the street and where a trellis or plants can disguise them. It is recommended that outside units NOT be placed on decks.
- 10. If piping is run along exterior siding, the homeowner assumes responsibility for future repairs and paint to siding. This to include dismantling of piping and reinstallation if required for siding repairs.
- 11. It is the owner's responsibility to maintain Unit(s)in proper working order and to the specifications set by the original manufacturer. Any defects or lack of maintenance that cause the unit to become a nuisance will entitle HOA to disconnect until proper repairs are made.
- 12. All outside units should be painted to match exterior siding.
- 13. When a propane tank is installed it must be housed in an enclosure which will be constructed with siding that matches the home and painted to match.
- 14. No consideration will be given if the home is out of compliance with any association policy.
