Since our inception in 1992, Randolph County Mayor's Committee for Disabled Persons has sought to improve the quality of life for persons with disabilities in the Randolph County area by promoting opportunities to work and live in an environment free of barriers imposed by architecture or attitude.



Randolph County Mayors Committee for Disabled Persons is classified as a public charity and has a 501 (c) (3) status. Our committee members include volunteers who

represent civic, church, municipal, educational, medical and professional entities as well as persons with disabilities and their advocates. We are governed by a volunteer executive committee and openly seek interested persons to join our committee and help us fulfill our mission.

Monthly meetings are open to the public so please join us. We meet the second Monday of each month at Asheboro City Hall (146 N. Church Street, Asheboro) in the Council Chambers at 1:00pm unless otherwise noted. By partnering with our nonprofit, you will be involved in a positive community based organization. The number of persons in NC facing life with a disability is on the rise. Often times the perception of being disabled comes with the view of being physically challenged by a lifelong circumstance. The reality is all of us can become disabled at any time in our life as accidents and diseases change our lives in an instant. The disabled are a political minority in that they have shared common discrimination, poverty, and barriers-both physical and attitudinal.

Position yourself or your organization to provide support to over 13% of Randolph County's total demographic.

Using data from the 2012 American Community Survey (ACS) the prevalence of disability by age in Randolph County was 13.1 % for persons of all ages. (For persons ages 65 - 74 this number doubles to 26.3% and quadruples to 51.9% for persons over the age of 75)
