

Puppy Supply List

Here is a list of general recommendations for items you may need for your puppy. Please plan to see your vet within 2-3 days of acquiring your puppy even though a vaccination is not immediately needed! Only your vet can provide a heartworm medication script, and that should start right away.

Harrington Doodles Provides: Vaccination/Deworming Records. 6 & 8 week vaccines given. Pup will need boosters at your vet. Small towel with smell of the pack.

General Items

Collar (small to start)

6' Leash

Longer leash or retractable (your preference)

ID tag

Harness (nice option if you'll be in areas where pup might start backing up and be able to slip out of collar)

Bowls

Flea & Tick prevention

Heartworm (script needed from your vet)

Health & Nutrition

Life's Abundance All Life Stages Dog Food (in the green bag) – Tips for ordering and saving. Order through link on at: Harringtondoodles.com/food. This is the only way we receive an email notification and record. Shipping is the same whether you order a 3-pound bag or ten 40-pound bags. Recommend ordering a couple of 20-pound bags at a time and SET for longest AUTO SHIP for 120 days. The auto ship does give a discount and you'll manually go in and hit "send order now" when you need more. Your puppy's food intake increases up until 9 month or so. At that time, you may decide to just have shipped what you need every couple of months or continue to order as needed. Please have food ordered a week or two before puppy pick up. Note: if you would like to switch to Life's Abundance puppy food, you may do so. We find our pups and dogs all do well with the protein levels in the All Life Stages.

NuVet Wafer Supplements- Tips for ordering and saving. Order through link at Harringtondoodles.com/food. This is the only way we receive a record. The supplement container has 90 wafers, so three-month supply. You can order a case of 4 canisters, pay shipping once, and be set for the year. Or order as you go. They have auto shipping options too. Please order a week or two prior to puppy pick up.

Toothbrush & Toothpaste

Slicker Brush (others work too)

Comb & Nail Clippers

Toys & Other

Deer Antlers (from pet supply store)

Fetch, Plush, Kong Toys - *Sharp puppy teeth can chew threw a Kong. Plush toys, even quicker. All of these are fine when supervised. Never leave toys in crate or pen area unsupervised.*

Puppy Play Pen & Crate Training

Crate (24 inch – 42 inch) – 24 inch is a little better for the playpen option; 42 more for full sized dog

Indoor Dog Fencing (for puppy play pen; Amazon has options; recommend 40 inch or higher – more stable)

Vinyl for under indoor dog fencing (Home Depot and Lowe's sell 6 x 8 remnants that work well)

Tinkle tray (photo on crate training page)
