We will be using Agility Gate for this trial. If you are unfamiliar with Agility Gate, you can check your dog in, mark them absent, mark them as having a conflict or mark them as running FEO.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move-ups must be received by 6pm on Monday, May 25, 2026. AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to Michele at dashagilitytrials@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name and what class you want the dog to move to.

If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition, a friend may do the mov-ups for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move-up must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from Novice "A" to Novice "B" class.

SET UP AND SECURITY

Set up will be on Friday, May 29, 2026 around 1 pm. Once we have the rings built and the trailer unloaded you can stake your set up area. All others can set up between 4-6pm.

There will be security but leave items at your own discretion.

MEASURING

Peyton Green is NOT a VMO. If you do not have a permanent height card, you must be measure before your first run.
