DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from trial grounds.

MEASURING AND JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division *lower* than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

On the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. However, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. **Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section4.**

MIXED HEIGHT ENTRIES

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard or Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either a MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that BOTH runs (Standard Agility run AND Jumpers With Weaves run) be either Regular OR Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the week.

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer **Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog in the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump heights card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

If either for or entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

DASH Agility Club of Southern CA is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the match's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed in the club's wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 1, 2025 by 11:00pm PST. Any entries withdrawn that are received by October 1, 2025 by 11:00pm PST will be replace by a wait-listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. PARKING AND SITE INFORMATION

NO ALCOHOL OR SMOKING ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.

No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the trial committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

HOSPITALITY

We will provide food for our workers. Must work at least one class before lunch. You will also receive a voucher along with lunch.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Ring size will be outside on grass. Each ring will be 100x120. The rings will be completely fenced in with a gate.

One warm up jump will be provided near each ring.

This is an AKC trial, therefore all dogs must be kept on leash except when at the practice jump or in the ring. Reminder, **your dog must be on leash before entering and exiting the ring.** Leaving the ring not on leash in AKC is an automatic E (elimination). Please be aware of your dog and follow the AKC rules.

<u>Judges are not required to wait for dogs</u>. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) FIX AND GO (FNG)

As of July 1, 2024 AKC has passed a new rule that FEO is allowed in all classes. DASH will allow FEO in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries, and must be entered, paid and recorded as such. The handler must declare FEO the day of the trial/at the time of the run. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare FEO on the day of the show
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team
 is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height
 changes are not allowed.
- If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier by checking in on Agility Gate or at the gate board
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Tovs may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food and treats are NOT allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop the run at any time

FNG is not pre-entered, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course. FNG may only be used once during a run in order to

continue the run. FNG more than once will result in the judge asking the competitor to immediately exit the ring.

COURSE WALK-THROUGH AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move-ups must be received by 6pm Monday, October 6th 2025. The AKC requires move-up requests to be in writing. Please send an email to dashagilitytrials@gmail.com with your dog's call name, the name and date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline, you may move your dog up on the first day of the trial for any **subsequent** days. If you are not showing on the first day you may still move your dog up for the following day. In addition, a friend may make the move-up request for you. You may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the last class of the day. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the trial. Exception: A dog which has been entered in Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered dues to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to Novice "B" under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification from the move from Novice "A" to Novice "B". Move-Down: After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in its class level (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request must be in writing and submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITOR

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial. Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. DASH and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. DASH reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to (i) decline entries for any cause or no cause, or (ii) remove any dog from the trial or trial venue on account of aggression. No exhibitor shall have any recourse or claim against DASH or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the

organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. As such, the club will refund less \$15 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent to jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged AMB have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
