11 **MR. SALICK:** NICHOLAS SALICK FOR PETITIONER, WHO
12 IS NOT PRESENT.

13 **THE COURT:** JUST ONE MOMENT.

14 WE'RE HERE TODAY REGARDING -- THE MATTER'S
15 SET FOR TRIAL-SETTING CONFERENCE, I'M TOLD, AND ALSO THE
16 HEARING FOR THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER.

17 THE PETITIONER -- A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
18 ORDER WAS ISSUED ON MARCH 25TH, 2016. AND LET ME JUST
19 LOOK AT THE -- NO, A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER WAS
20 GRANTED ON MARCH 25TH, 2016. AND IT HAS BEEN CONTINUED
21 SEVERAL TIMES.

22 THE LAST TIME YOU ALL WERE HERE WAS
23 JULY 20TH, 2016, AND IT WAS CONTINUED. THE PARTIES
24 STIPULATED TO CONTINUE THE T.R.O. TO THE TRIAL-SETTING
25 CONFERENCE DATE SET AUGUST 25TH, 2016, TO ALLOW THE
26 PARTIES AND COUNSEL TO TRY TO REACH A GLOBAL SETTLEMENT
27 PRIOR TO TRIAL. AND IT'S MY UNDERSTANDING THAT YOU'RE
28 REQUESTING ANOTHER CONTINUANCE.

1 **MR. SALICK:** THAT IS CORRECT.

2 **THE COURT:** OKAY.

3 **MR. SALICK:** I GOT A CALL ABOUT A WEEK AGO.
4 RESPONDENT'S COUNSEL, ANAT -- EXCUSE ME -- MS. RESNIK,
5 INDICATED -- HER OFFICE INDICATED SHE WOULD NOT BE
6 AVAILABLE TODAY. IT WAS OUR INTENTION TO GO FORWARD.
7 AND SO LATE LAST NIGHT, IT WAS AFTER THE COURTHOUSE HAD
8 CLOSED, MS. RESNIK CALLED ME AND SAID THAT SHE INTENDED
9 ON DOING DISCOVERY TO DETERMINE MY CLIENT'S CURRENT
10 INCOME. HER CLIENT, THE RESPONDENT, IS IN VANCOUVER AND
11 WAS UNABLE TO PERSONALLY APPEAR AND MS. RESNIK DOES HAVE
12 A CONFLICT THIS MORNING IN VAN NUYS.

13 SO, SHE AND I DID SPEAK. IT'S OUR STRONG
14 DESIRE TO GET THIS CASE COMPLETED. SO WE DID AGREE TO
15 REISSUE THE T.R.O. WE DID AGREE TO CONTINUE THE
16 TRIAL-SETTING CONFERENCE. I DID SAY THAT I DID WANT TO
17 GET A DEADLINE WITH RESPECT TO THE EXCHANGE OF THE
18 P.D.D.'S AS WELL AS DISCOVERY.

19 **THE COURT:** OKAY. WELL, THE T.R.O., THE REQUEST
20 TO CONTINUE THE T.R.O. -- FIRST LET ME ASK YOU, WHAT
21 DATE ARE YOU REQUESTING?

22 **MR. SALICK:** I WOULD THINK 60 DAYS OUT.

23 **THE COURT:** NOT FOR THE T.R.O. BECAUSE THE T.R.O.
24 HAS TO BE HEARD WITHIN 21 DAYS UNLESS THE OPPOSITION IS
25 WAIVING TIME, AND THEY'RE NOT HERE TO WAIVE TIME. SO
26 THE T.R.O. DOES NOT HAVE TO NECESSARILY TRACK THE T.S.C.

27 **MR. SALICK:** OKAY.

28 **THE COURT:** AND WE COULD HAVE PROCEEDED WITH THE

1 T.R.O., THE D.V.R.O. HEARING IF YOUR CLIENT WAS HERE.
2 IT'S NOT ENOUGH FOR COUNSEL TO SAY, ONE, SHE'S NOT
3 APPEARING IN COURT, AND TWO, SHE HAS A CONFLICT, WHEN
4 YOU ALL AGREED TO THIS DATE FOR THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
5 RESTRAINING ORDER HEARING.

6 SO, THE -- WITH YOUR REPRESENTATION AND
7 COUNSEL NOT PRESENT, WE CAN ONLY CONTINUE THE T.R.O.
8 UNTIL THE 21ST DAY. AND IF SHE'S NOT HERE THAT DAY,
9 YOUR CLIENT STILL WISHES TO GO FORWARD, WE CAN GO
10 FORWARD OR YOU ALL WILL HAVE TO TAKE THE MATTER OFF
11 CALENDAR.

12 **MR. SALICK:** LET'S --

13 **THE COURT:** WE CAN'T CONTINUE PAST THAT DATE.

14 **MR. SALICK:** UNDERSTOOD. THEN, YES, LET'S SET THE
15 HEARING ON THE PERMANENT RESTRAINING ORDERS 21 DAYS OR
16 LESS, PLEASE.

17 **THE CLERK:** SEPTEMBER 16.

18 **THE COURT:** SO THE -- COUNSEL, THE COURT IS GOING
19 TO ORDER FOR YOU TO GIVE NOTICE TO THE OPPOSITION.

20 SO THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER THAT WAS
21 ISSUED ON MARCH 25TH, 2016, AND THAT WAS REISSUED UNTIL
22 JULY 20TH, 2016, AND THEN REISSUED UNTIL TODAY'S DATE,
23 FINAL CONTINUANCE ON THIS MATTER IS CONTINUED UNTIL
24 SEPTEMBER 16, 2016.

25 **MR. SALICK:** DID THE COURT SAY THE FINAL
26 CONTINUANCE?

27 **THE COURT:** IT'S THE FINAL CONTINUANCE BECAUSE,
28 TECHNICALLY, IT SHOULDN'T BE CONTINUED AGAIN. YOU ONLY

1 GET ONE CONTINUANCE, BOTH SIDES GET ONE CONTINUANCE AND
2 YOU ALREADY AGREED TO THE AUGUST 25TH. IT'S BEEN
3 CONTINUED SEVERAL TIMES.

4 **MR. SALICK:** IT HAS.

5 **THE COURT:** SO THAT IS FOR -- SO THAT IS A GO DATE
6 FOR THE D.V.R.O. AND TRIAL SETTING CONFERENCE. WE CAN
7 CONTINUE THAT FOR A DIFFERENT DATE IF YOU ALL STILL HAVE
8 THE OUTSTANDING DISCOVERY. BUT UNDERSTAND THAT THE
9 OUTSTANDING DISCOVERY HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH THE
10 D.V.R.O.

11 **MR. SALICK:** UNDERSTOOD.

12 **THE COURT:** SO DO YOU WISH TO CONTINUE THE T.S.C.
13 TO A DIFFERENT DATE?

14 **MR. SALICK:** YES, PLEASE.

15 **THE COURT:** OKAY. COULD I HAVE A 60-DAY DATE,
16 PLEASE?

17 **THE CLERK:** OCTOBER 28TH.

18 **THE COURT:** OCTOBER 28, 2016, AND THE COURT IS
19 GOING TO ORDER -- IN THE EVENT THEY ARE NOT COMPLETED,
20 THE COURT IS GOING TO ORDER BOTH SIDES TO COMPLETE,
21 SERVE, FILE PROOF OF SERVICE OF THEIR PRELIMINARY
22 DECLARATIONS OF DISCLOSURE AND THEIR FINAL DECLARATIONS
