1 FOR ORDER FOR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER. A
2 TEMPORARY ORDER WAS GRANTED ON JUNE 22ND, 2016. THIS MATTER HAS
3 BEEN CONTINUED ON THIS ISSUE FOR QUITE SOME TIME, AND HOW DO THE
4 PARTIES WISH TO PROCEED?

5 MR. SALICK: YOUR HONOR, COUNSEL AND I AND MY CLIENT, AND
6 OPPOSING COUNSEL IS ALSO SPEAKING WITH HER CLIENT, I BELIEVE,
7 WHO IS IN CANADA, AND WE'VE COME TO AN AGREEMENT TO DISMISS THE
