

In case any of you missed this, it was in the Spring issue of SEMPER FI magazine, written by National Vice Commandant, Mideast Division, Rick Thomason. It struck me as being spot on, and I would like to share it with you....

"Do you ever think about why the windshield of your car is so large and the rear-view mirror is so small? It is probably because what is in front of you is much more important than what you have left behind. It is true with every aspect of your life. Whether it is your Marine past or your civilian world. We can look back and talk about how we love the old days, but the old days will not love you back. Only if you look forward to the next stage of your life with optimism and a smile will there be true happiness. I know I am probably preaching to the choir, but it is true.

"In the MCL, we tend to hang in the past with our ideas of what is right and how things should be done. Well, we need to turn that around and look to the future. The Marine Corps is not living in the past, it is a rapidly developing, multifaceted, warfare machine that keeps bringing new equipment and techniques into today's world. That should be the Marine Corps League also. We must develop new methodology for recruitment of new members. We must increase the awareness of the Marine Corps League in the eyes of the public. We must look to the new and reflect on the old to avoid making the same mistakes. Do not be part of the problem by thinking, it worked in the past. So did throwing rocks and pointed sticks for self-defense. Do not be the neanderthal in the group that refuses to accept change. It is inevitable.
