Unfortunately, there were no VA visits during January! Future looks a little bleak at the moment, however, what I'd like to do is reach out with a phone call to our own Detachment Members who are ill or homebound. I would also send them a card from our whole Detachment. Carol suggested I could send the cards she and Ed Mampe bought for our veterans on our VA visits. It's extremely important to let all our own members know that we think & care about them too!

If you are home bound, give Linda a phone call.

I'm in the very beginning process of getting vetted again. I just filled out an application for regular employment. (Yes, you read this correctly) It's mandatory that all volunteers have to do this. I heard it's a very long process and I will keep everyone posted. Covid vaccines are no longer required; however you must have a flu shot and proof is required. You must also have a Real Illinois State ID (with a Star on it) or a passport in order to proceed with the vetting process.

ATTENTION - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGARDING VA HOSPITAL VISITATIONS

All our team members should have received a letter from Kenneth List, Chief, Community Affairs, stating effective October 1, 2025 all volunteers for periods of longer than six months are required to complete a more thorough background check and receive a new type of ID badge called a PIV badge. This new ID badge will be valid for five (5) years. This is part of a nationwide change to ensure the safety of their patients. This is the same background check their employees receive. As part of this background check, I have the information we need to get started.

1. We need to fill this information out and return to the VA. After they have received our information, they will send us a questionnaire (via our email address) that we have to complete online. Help is available if anyone needs assistance in this process. Please contact Jiji Joseph at 224-610-3714. Our current badges are valid until April, 2026. We are allowed to continue to volunteer until this time. So we have until now until April to get this accomplished. It is mandatory that we all go through this new process if we want to continue to volunteer.

2. We need to make an appointment with DMV for a Real Illinois State ID with a Star on it or a passport. The fee is \$20.00. We need to bring all original copies of our birth certificate, social security card, driver's license or regular state ID, and a copy of a recent bill paid that can verify our home residence.

3. After we've received our Real Illinois State ID or passport, we need to contact Jiji Joseph at 224-610-3714 to schedule an appointment with her, our new photo pic & and fingerprint appointment to save us extra trips to the VA. She's located at 3001 Green Bay Road, Building 135, Room 257 in North Chicago.

4. It's also mandatory for FHCC to have a flu vaccination. We can have this done at the VA in Employee Health with an appointment. If we had our flu vaccine done elsewhere, we need to bring a copy of verification from where we received the vaccine. If we do not wish to get the flu vaccination, we need to sign a form and we will be required to wear a mask when we volunteer. No covid vaccination is required.

I know this is a whole lot for us to do and if anyone has any questions, I'll be more than happy to try and assist.

We meet in the canteen area the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month at 1:00 pm. We still would like to invite anyone from our Detachment to attend a one-time visit until April, 2026 (afterward you must go through this new process also). You must have had a flu shot and wear a mask to ensure the safety and well-being of our Veterans and their families. This will provide for a safe and successful volunteer experience.
