According to the Insurance Information Institute, "Overall losses from world-wide natural catastrophes in 2020, totaled \$210 billion dollars, significantly higher than \$166 billion in 2019. ...Ranked by insured losses, the top five costliest natural catastrophes were events that occurred in the United States." Hurricane Laura was ranked the number one costliest disaster in 2020, impacting both Texas and Louisiana.

In our 2019 donor statement, we stated that, "This year we have renewed our commitment to our ministry by making our mission our sole ministry and laser focus for 2020. We feel that God has confirmed within us that this is our year to GO." We had no idea how true this was going to be.

We were so grateful for all of you who dug deep and donated to this ministry so we specifically could go where God called us. This year our destination was Louisiana. Normally, when we go serve, God gives us many real-life fishes and loaves stories! (Read John 6) This year he gave us incredible examples of Manna! (Exodus 16) He provided exactly what we need for every single day and nothing more. Even when we left, we were not sure if we would be able to cook more than a day or two. But in the end, we were able to serve 11 days, feeding over 4,000 people and even had several opportunities to make friendships that will last a lifetime.

We must give special thanks to Pastor Wayne Dartez, his wife Arlene Dartez and family, and his congregation at Victory Baptist Church, for accepting us into their church family (and parking lot) while we were in LA. Even though their homes and most of their church was damaged, they ran an exceptional food and supply pantry inside their school and served their community with great love, strength, and courage.

Also, we wanted to give our thanks and love to Marion Baptist Church in Marion, TX for helping us to get on the road, and their willingness to always love and support missionaries. They are an amazing example of a sending church!

The HolyRollers Ministries is also supported by The Wildfire Network, which provides free support to missions like ours to have greater success in following their calling in obedience to God. The Wildfire Network generously donated a grant to our mission. As well as encouragement and prayer that the Lord would provide all that we need.

When we returned from our mission this year, we came home to play catch up on bills, Christmas, and 2 completely dead vehicles. God provided abundantly for each day and circumstance and we are so grateful. We want to give a special thanks to Steve and Sabrina Parker for sacrificing one of their vehicles to our family so we could continue forward and prayerfully listen for God's will on making plans for our next vehicle. (We found a temporary solution so we can continue to plan for the truck we will need in the future.) Their family also pastors/ministers the New Braunfels Bible Baptist Church for the Deaf and Hearing.

And finally thank you to our amazing children who also joyfully serve the Lord! Liam and Haidyn were both amazing cooks and servers in the food trailer during our Louisiana mission as well as a runner to help everyone. Also, we got to see Mackenzie's gifts truly shine for the first time as she helped in the food pantry, with confident joy and efficiency!

She is diligently working on scholarship opportunities and was accepted to the Music Department there, as she feels God is directing her towards Worship Ministry.
