Ministry Requirements

- 1. Have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior (John 3:16), read and agree to C4C Statement of Belief
- 2. Complete and submit the "Canines for Christ Volunteer Application Form"
- 3. Must have current vaccine record of dog on file with the completed application.
- 4. The dog must be a minimum of six months old.
- 5. Provide the AKC Canine Good Citizen Evaluation Form or approved Therapy Dog certification.
- 6. Submit a headshot picture of your dog for use on your business cards.
- 7. Follow the guidelines in the Volunteer Manual to include wearing C4C shirt and/or identification on their person and the dog is wearing their C4C vest or bandana.
- 8. Agree to pass out, as appropriate, the card with your dog's picture and the message of God's plan of salvation.
- 9. Agree, as appropriate, to listen and offer to share God's message of love and hope.
