THE CITADEL CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA ATHLETIC GRANT-IN-AID

I understand that I have been recommended to the Committee on Scholarships for a grant-in-aid at The Citadel. The amount and terms of this grant are:

A Full (100%) Percent NCAA Athletic Grant for the 2015-16 academic school year, subject to NCAA changes. This grant includes any applicable out-of-state tuition waiver in accordance with institutional and NCAA policy.

- I. As a recipient of this grant, I understand that it is awarded for a period of one academic year and is subject to all NCAA regulations and that if it is to be renewed, it must be renewed prior to 1 July each year. The grant is valid in the sport of SOCCER as long as I:
 - 1. Maintain a satisfactory conduct and suitability record as a student at The Citadel;
 - Meet the academic requirements and rules of The Citadel, the Southern Conference and the National Collegiate Athletic Association; make normal progress toward graduation, and maintain my eligibility for participation in intercollegiate athletic competition as an undergraduate cadet;
 - 3. Do not voluntarily withdraw from the sport of SOCCER for personal reasons; and
 - 4. Comply with all athletic department rule or policies included in the Cadet-Student-Athlete Handbook.
- II. I understand that any aid offered or given by any other person except from my parents or legal guardian to attend The Citadel or to influence my preference is impermissible and could cause me to be declared ineligible and to forfeit this grant.
- III. If injured while participating in athletics supervised by a member of the coaching staff, and if I thereby become physically unable to participate in games as certified by the college surgeon, I understand that this grant will be continued, provided I maintain the standards outlined above as an undergraduate cadet.
- IV. The training rules and Athletic Department rules and policies for intercollegiate athletics at The Citadel are considered rules of the college, and I agree to abide by them, giving full and willing cooperation in contributing my best efforts to the whole program at The Citadel. Failure to abide by these training rules, Athletics Department rules and policies, or stipulations outlined in the Cadet-Student-Athlete Handbook may result in reduction or cancellation of athletically-related aid during the term of the award and/or may result in non-renewal of athletically-related aid.
- V. This grant is subject to approval of the Committee on Scholarships and successful completion of your preparatory or high school degree and successful admission to The Citadel.
- VI. NCAA regulations restrict the total amount of financial aid a student can receive. If I receive some other scholarship or financial aid award(s), I will notify the Financial Aid Office. Those funds may replace a portion of the athletics grant in order to meet the NCAA and conference regulations.
- VII. Having read the above Agreement carefully, I hereby agree to accept this grant.
