#### WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS?

##### Clothing Requirements:

Combination Class, Pom, Jazz, and Acrobatics: Students are to wear form-fitting dancewear. Leotards, tights, dance pants, booty shorts, dance tops, etc.

Hip Hop students may wear dancewear or exercise type clothing.

Ballet must have any color leotard and black or pink tights. Hair in bun!

##### Shoe Requirements:

Combination Class: black patent tap shoes and pink or black ballet shoes

Pom: jazz shoes

Jazz: tan or black slip on jazz shoes

Ballet: Pink ballet shoes

Dancers can wear their costumes to dance class this week! Make sure they can still dance in their costumes 😊 We will also have a small party at the end of classes.

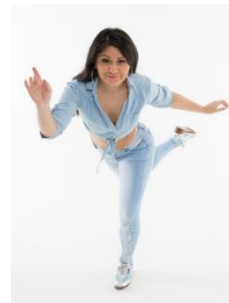
**The studio will be closed on
