Freechoice: Explore the city on foot on a guided walking tour, or visit moving WWII sites and learn about this dark era in the city's history. Alternatively, choose to stay on board for a beer tasting experience.

Day 12 Thu, 29 Sep Bamberg (B,L,D)

Freechoice: Take a guided tour of the Old Town of Bamberg and walk the same cobbled streets as medieval traders once did. Alternatively, taste some of the citys regional specialities on a city walk.

Freechoice: Visit Würzburg's Bishop's Residenz Palace and sample some exquisite local wine in the underground cellars, or visit the impressive estate of Schloss Weikersheim, a true Baroque and Renaissance delight. Alternatively,

Immerse yourself in charming Rüdesheim and board the Winzerexpress mini-train for a guided visit of Siegfried's

Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum. Then enjoy a cable car ride to the Niederwald Monument for spectacular views
