Guidelines for Harvest Full of Hope Board Members.

All board members are elected to their roles by a majority vote of existing board members. The board strives to elect members who represent the attendees of the Harvest Full of Hope conference. All board members are required to submit a copy of their resume and cover letter (suggested) to be considered for open board positions. The following responsibilities are to be maintained by board members or the member will be removed from their role. Board members may also be removed by a majority vote at a board meeting after a call for removal is made by a current board member. Call for removal can be considered from a non board member but required a unanimous vote for removal, with the exception of the member in question.

Board member expectations:

Attend: Board members are required to attend no less than 75% of board meetings.

Participate: Board members are required to actively participate in planning and discussions at board meetings.

Lead: Board members are expected to work towards the advancement of the organizations mission.

Conduct: Board members are expected to behave legally and ethically both publicly and privately.

Engage: Board members are expected to actively represent Harvest full of Hope to the community and relevant interests.

Objectivity: Board members must reveal any actual or perceived conflicts of interest. Board members must recuse themselves from involvement in decisions when a conflict of interest arises or if they cannot remain objective.
