Beechmont Civil Works – Local Council

Year: 2023 **Duration:** 22 weeks

Value: Approx. \$1.9 million

Construct and concrete 3.2km of shared bikeway, footpath and a creek crossing, including safety hand rails, bollards and bulk earthworks. Multiple underground services were not recorded on any plans or DBYD; a ground penetrating radar and vacuum excavation were used to safely identify and locate all services which resulted in no strikes or damage to any underground services.



Dredging Works – Queensland Urban Utilities (QUU)

Year: 2022 **Duration:** 16 weeks (ongoing contracts)

Value: Approx. \$2.3 million

We delivered efficient waste removal for several QUU WWTPs across SEQ. Utilising our floatable dredge unit, polymer dosing system, and geo-bags, we removed over 95% of waste material from their holding ponds. This innovative approach maximised water reuse by removing only debris, all while avoiding plant shutdowns and delays. The project resulted in a significant increase of over 65% in the ponds holding capacity.



Toowoomba Flood Recovery (DRFA) – Austek Roads

Year: 2024 **Duration:** 6 months

Value: Approx. \$2.1 million

We mobilised a comprehensive crew, including a dedicated supervisor, civil roadworks specialists, 5-14t excavators, bobcat with road broom, graders, rollers, and water trucks, to complete flood remediation works. We encountered challenges with black soil and gravel quality and availability; with close collaboration with client inspectors/engineers, we ensured minimal project delays and maintained the highest quality standards.



M1 Mudgeeraba Interchange – Local Government

Year: 2022 **Duration:** 12 weeks

Value: Approx. \$1.28 million

We successfully rehabilitated an 800m section of a creek, employing de-watering and de-silting techniques. Our team constructed a new concrete swale drain to improve drainage, adhering to stringent Tier 1 HSEQ regulations and design specifications throughout the project. Despite encountering a major rain event, we delivered the project on time, on budget, and with a zero incident safety record.

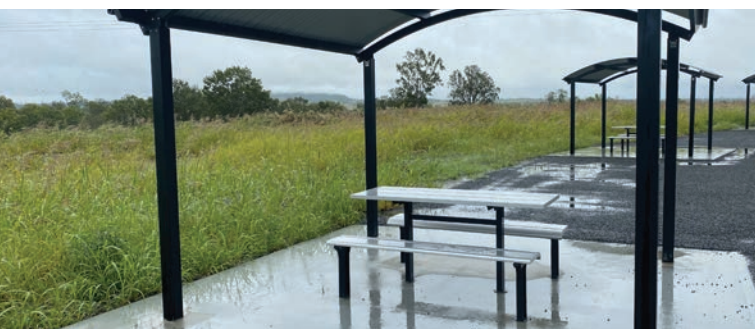


Landslip Slope Stabilisation – Local Council

Year: 2024 **Duration:** 2 weeks (night shift)

Value: Approx. \$650,000

Our team provided expert civil excavation and engineering services for a planned landslide stabilisation project. Utilising excavators with specialised attachments, we drilled and installed 2m and 4m (150mm diameter) soil nails to reinforce the roadside batter. To ensure safety during road closures and night works, we developed a detailed traffic management plan and conducted rigorous risk assessments before each stage of construction.



Truck Rest Stop Construction – Local Government

Year: 2022 **Duration:** 3 months

Value: Approx. \$680,000

We delivered a comprehensive road rehabilitation project, encompassing concreting, drainage work, street furniture placement, subgrade preparation, and new asphalt laying. We fostered a collaborative work environment by integrating industry youth and Indigenous trainees throughout the project, providing valuable on-the-job training and experience. All works were executed in strict adherence to TMR specifications.



Controlled Vegetation Burn – Local Government

Year: 2023 **Duration:** 4 weeks

Value: Approx. \$250,000

Liaise and coordinate with Bigambul First Nations Firefighters to complete a controlled burn of vegetation to maintain firebreaks. Despite windy weather throughout the project, our HSEQ team ensured all risks were mitigated, contingencies were in place, and completed the project on time, on budget, and exceeded our client's expectations.



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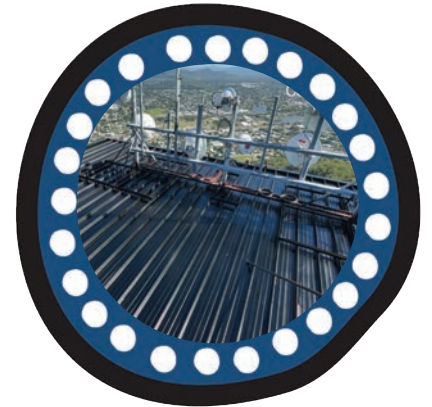
