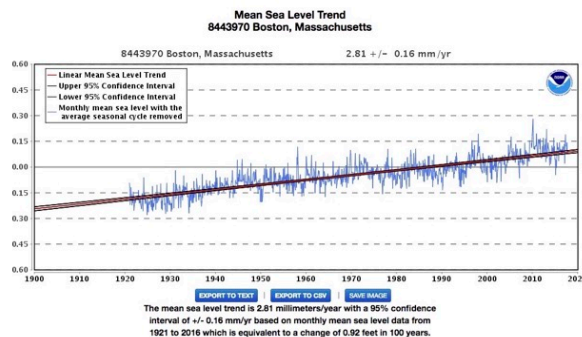
What do we know about sea level rise today?
