



## PHYSICAL EXAMINATION POLICY

WE WILL FOLLOW THE BOISE SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY WHICH READS - STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN ATHLETICS (GRADE 9-12) WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE TWO PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS (BEGINNING OF 9TH AND 11TH GRADE YEARS) FOLLOWED BY A YEARLY INTERIM QUESTIONNAIRE TO BE FILLED OUT BY THE PARENTS. THE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION IS TO BE DONE ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS. THE EXPENSE INCURRED FOR THE PHYSICAL WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ATHLETE. THE EXAMINATION IS TO BE CONDUCTED BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN AFTER MAY 15TH OF THE 8TH AND 10TH GRADE YEARS. IF YOU HAVE HAD A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FOR A TIMBERLINE SANCTIONED SPORT YOU DO NOT NEED TO COMPLETE A NEW ONE.
