




Enterprise Risk Management

Application Process:

- 1. Interested applicants should submit a resume and cover letter on our Career page on our website
- 2. Selected candidates will be invited to participate in a preliminary introduction interview.
- 3. Selected candidates will be invited to participate in a final interview.
- 4. Final decisions will be made based on the candidate's qualifications, goals, degree, and fit with the program objectives.



Program Components

The program components include the objectives each intern will experience throughout their internship.

Orientation

Interns will receive an introduction to Leswee LLC and our policies and procedures.

Professional Development

Interns will participate in training sessions on various topics, including communication skills, project management, and networking.

- Interns will have the opportunity to participate in professional development activities, including training sessions, workshops, and networking events.
- Interns will spend time shadowing different departments to gain an understanding of our operations and processes.

Project Work
