Elections

Most – but not all – school board races are to be engaged in November. And the news from those conducted during the Primary is largely good, with several threatening SoCal races resolved according to democratic values of inclusion, civil rights and good governance.

School Board Incursions

The Children's Caucus (CademCC) has presented its road show to several County Committees. Titled Non-partisan, Down Ballot School Board Races Are Our Electoral Achilles Heel, its goal is to raise consciousness among our electorate, particularly at distance to central Party convocations in big cities like Sacramento (past) and San Diego (announcement below).

Protecting Our Children; AG Bonta Visits!


