The Executive Board (E-board) of the CA Democratic Party wilkonvene in San Diego next weekend. And while E-Board members are expected to attend in person, caucus members – required simply to be registered as a Democrat in California – may attend our meeting remotely, via Zoom. If attending in person, please beware of restrictions on what may be brought inside the facility. Official notifications are on CADEM's website.

Our program next weekend, held in the <u>Sheraton San Diego Hotel &</u> <u>Marina</u>, will feature three special presentations from local experts in the field of <u>Child welfare</u>, <u>Family services and Mental health</u>.

Joining us will be the San Diego County Child Welfare Director, **Dr. Kimberly Giardina**; lived experience and professional expert **Ms. Mirna Ariza**; and San Ysidro Health's Chief Behavioral Health Officer, **Dr. Gaurav Mishra**. Together they will present some context, perspective, and experience around some of the practical, legislative and systemic challenges and opportunities faced today by professionals working with children inside California's public social systems.

This promises to be a tremendously informative and interesting program; we are all excited for you to join us for this hybrid meeting, either in person (details here) or via zoom (registration here).

Please review the program's whole agenda <u>here</u>. Take a moment to review the <u>minutes</u> from our last meeting, in Sacramento, and our updated <u>Bylaws</u>, which we hope the membership will approve, prerequisite to our Caucus' recertification-vote at Sunday's floor session.

Also at the meeting we will hear a brief history of the Children's Caucus and a *memorium* to one of its founding members, the former State Superintendent of Public Instruction, **Delaine Eastin**.

Finally we will hear from our caucus officers, reporting with a special emphasis on the program's focus of child welfare, mental health and family services.

If there are school board candidates present, their political introductions at the microphone will be prioritized during the evening's final 20 minutes showcasing ballot initiatives and candidates for elected office.

Advocating For Our Children:

The Children's Caucus recommended an official position of "support" on

nine bills (below) from the CDP standing Committee on Legislation, and stands in solidarity with a "support" position for three additional bills. The Party's endorsement is recommended in Committee and brought to the full floor on Sunday for official E-board membership vote.

As a constituent entity of the California Democratic Party, the Children's Caucus does not endorse independently, but speaks with the Party through "OneVoice". Our Childrens' Voice is represented at the CADEM Executive Board Meeting by you, and through you. Make a plan to visit and speak out for *them* at the Legislation Committee meeting, tentatively scheduled for Friday at 1pm.
