Our introductory meetings

Last week in a series of three meetings, members of our working committees introduced themselves and brainstormed ideas for the space defined by the intersection of (a) what we can do as a caucus logistically, (b) what our working committees should do strategically and (c) how to optimize our advantage as a statewide, special-interest caucus of the state's dominant, political Party?

The first two conversations converged around the same action, that defining our vision as a working caucus in 2022/23 is crucial. Accordingly, the current testimony around the CDP Platform being heard in a <u>series of meetings</u> leading up to the August Visalia <u>Executive Board</u> meeting (<u>Join Us!</u>), will be critical in articulating our own, working mission, too. The plank on *Children*, *Young Adults, and Their Families* is being <u>heard on August 6th</u> at 10am, and we are organizing to be heard there.

In the end, it is the Platform committee that writes the <u>CDP Children's</u> <u>Platform</u>, but they do so guided by input from Democrats statewide. Our caucus members' expertise in children's issues can influence the shape and direction of the Platform. Our working committee members agreed to offer testimony, and set a meeting to develop our thoughts around these:
