Below is summary information for the 2023-2024 AI Kalfus Long Island Math Fair. There will only be one round of the Fair for all Nassau and Suffolk students. Every student will submit a paper electronically and the presentation will occur in person at Hofstra University. There are no guarantees of a medal.

**A. DEADLINES:**

- Applications uploaded/emailed by **Friday, January 26, 2024**
- Papers electronically submitted by **Monday, March 4, 2024**

**B. SCHEDULE:**

- **The Fair will take place at Hofstra University on Friday April 5, 2024**
- Plan to arrive as close to 2:00 as possible. Inform us of any judge who will arrive after 2:30 prior to the event.
- Judging in classrooms will begin at 3:00

**C. FEE SCHEDULE:** (calculated per student whether they enter as an individual or part of a team)

- 1 – 4 students = \$110.00 Each additional student = \$15.00
- The entry fee is non-refundable. An invoice (form C) is enclosed. **Please make checks payable to NCAMS.**

**D. JUDGES:**

- 1 judge for every 4 students is REQUIRED for your school (even if students enter individually or on a team)
- Each judge is REQUIRED to view the Judging Tutorial Procedures, which will be shared in the future
- Each school advisor or sponsoring teacher must attest to the originality of each student's paper

**E. ENTRY LEVELS:**

- Students enter according to their current grade level, not the math course in which they are enrolled
- Individual levels: grade 7- 12
- Team levels: grade 7-8

**F. SCHOOL CONTACT PERSON, ADVISOR or SPONSORING TEACHER:**

- **Applications Uploaded / Emailed** to the Google Drive by **January 26, 2024:**
  - **EACH STUDENT** must complete **this Form A-1**
  - **EACH TEAM** must complete **this Form A-2**
  - **EACH SCHOOL** must complete **this School Registration Form B**
- **Upload final student papers** to the Google Drive by **March 4, 2024:**

**G. TEAMS (Grades 7-8 Only):**

- Teams compete only against other teams, and no student can enter both on a team and as an individual. A team will produce one paper. An individual entry may not be converted to a team entry and vice versa. No team changes can be made after the application deadline.
- Two or three students can make up a team. Team members can be from different grade levels but must enter on the oldest student's grade level. No student replacements are allowed. All students must be from one school.

**H. AWARDS:**

- Judges will award either a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medal, or No Medal to the papers they adjudicate. All medals will be available for pick up at the end of the Fair.
