A History of Helping Children

The Humanitarian Foundation was started in 1949 by the Grottoes of North America with a focus on Cérebral Palsy research. Since 1969, the focus of the Dental Program includes children with

- o Cerebral Palsy
- Muscular Dystrophy (and related neuromuscular disorders)
- Intellectual Disability (at least 2 yrs overall delay)
 - Down Syndrome
- o Organ Transplant Surgery

In the past 5 years the Humanitarian Foundation:

- o Served 6,023 children
- o Paid over \$4.1 million for dental services
- o Partners with over 300 dentists in 32 states and Canada

The Need Continues to Grow

- 11 million children in the US have special health care needs – that's 15.1% of all children - CDC
- Tooth decay has increased by 15% in the past 10 years among kids ages 2 to 5 years old – Pew Center
- Dental care is the single greatest unmet need for health services among children – Dept. of Job & Family Services
- Cost for special needs children is higher than normal dental care with average cost of \$750/visit
- Once a child is accepted into the Dental Program, we can provide dental care until they are 21 years old
- The Dental Program supports both preventative and emergency care

Dental Care Program

Any child under the age of 21, regardless of race, creed, or color with a qualifying condition is welcome to participate in the program. The Dental Care Program is always the secondary carrier when primary insurance is involved. The program does not cover patients who are covered by Medicaid. The program does not cover any type of orthodontics, reconstructive jaw surgeries or implants. All dental treatment is required to be preauthorized with the exception of: initial exam, x-rays, prophy, and fluoride.
